An application for registration by a person wishing to vote by post must be made before 12.00 noon on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2011, and the sealed envelope containing the completed ballot and other documentation must be returned to the Judicial Greffe by no later than noon on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2011, in order for the vote to be included in the count.
