- 1. An elector whose application to vote by post has been granted is disqualified from voting in person at the polling station on election day.

An application by a person wishing to register to vote by post must be made before noon on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2016, and the sealed envelope containing the completed ballot paper and other documentation must be returned to the Judicial Greffe by no later than noon on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2016, in order for the vote to be included in the count.
