



Electoral Register

Apply to register/update your details/opt-out of or opt-in to candidates' list

(Articles 6A and 12 - Elections (Jersey) Law 2002)

Please read this information:

With effect from 24 March 2026, the names and addresses of those who are entitled to vote will automatically be added to the Electoral Register. This is based on information held by the Government of Jersey which is passed to your Parish in accordance with the Elections Law.

You are entitled to be registered to vote if you are ordinarily resident in Jersey and are or will, within 3 months, be

- 16 years old or over and
- have lived in the Island for either:
 - A the last 12 months or
 - B the last 6 months plus additional period(s) that total at least 5 years

You can check with your Parish Hall that you are registered to vote (contact details overleaf).

If your details are not included or are incorrect, complete the form overleaf to:

- ✓ Add your name to the electoral register if it is not included (you can only be registered in one electoral district at any time)
- ✓ Amend your details if they are incorrect e.g. you have a new name/moved address
- ✓ Opt-out of (or opt-in again to) the candidates' list.

The Electoral Register is NOT available for public inspection but a copy is provided to candidates in an election. You can choose to opt out of the candidates' list if you do not want candidates to see your name and address.

- Your details will still appear on the electoral register and you can vote.
- Your opt-out will remain if you move address in Jersey.
- Your opt-out will be removed if you move away from Jersey.
- You may opt-in again at any time by notifying your Parish of your decision.

All information you give us must be correct otherwise you may not be eligible to vote. **Please also inform the Government of Jersey of your correct details (name, address, residence).**

PRIVACY: Your Parish is registered with the Office of the Information Commissioner in Jersey and is a 'controller', as defined by the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018 (DPJL), of the information (personal data) you provide in connection with your application to register to vote.

We collect: Your personal details (surname, title, forenames, date of birth), telephone number, email, period of ordinary residence date/category, and signature. Once you are registered to vote an electoral number is created which identifies your electoral record. All personal data is stored securely and retained in accordance with your Parish's Data Retention Policy.

Our use of your personal data: Your Parish requires your personal data in order to process your application to register to vote in accordance with the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002. We use your information at elections to enable you to vote. We also use your information to enable you to attend and vote at Parish and Ecclesiastical Assemblies.

Transfer of personal data to third parties: The Parishes share your personal data collected for this purpose between themselves and in accordance with the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 (and certain other relevant laws) which provides for the register (or part thereof)

- to be available to candidates standing in an election; who are permitted to use your information for campaigning purposes,
- to be provided to the Viscount's Department; who use your information to administer jury service.

Your rights: You can ask us for a copy of the information we hold about you and to correct or update this. Whilst you can ask us to stop or restrict the processing of your personal data, we are not obliged to do so where there is a statutory need to process your data or if there are compelling legitimate or public interests in continuing to process the data.
