Stop and think



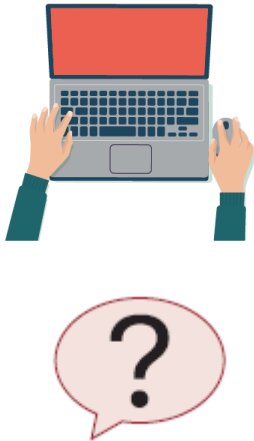
The Jersey Election is on Sunday 7 June 2026.

You may see lots of information about:

- Candidates
- Voting
- The election

Not all information is true.

Stop and think before you trust information.



New technology (like AI) can:

- Create fake news
- Make realistic images
- Copy voices and videos

These can look real but **may not be true.**

Be careful and protect your vote.

If something seems:

- Strange
- Shocking
- Too dramatic

Stop and check it first.



Things you can do



Things you can do:

- Check where the information comes from
- Look for an **imprint** (who made it)
- Ask: *Who created this and why?*



If you are not sure:

- Do not share it
- Try to check it first

You can also:

- Help friends and family check information



Report anything that seems wrong.

If you see something that may be:

- Fake
- Misleading
- Harmful

Things you can do



You can report it to:

- Social media platforms

Or contact:

- States of Jersey Police
(for serious cases)

Examples of serious problems:

- Fake information about voting
- Threats or intimidation
- Attempts to interfere with the election

Everyone can help by:

- Thinking before sharing
- Checking facts
- Being careful online

The Jersey Electoral Authority is independent.

- It does not take sides in politics
- It makes sure that elections are fair
- It also looks at how candidates behave during elections
